

Seating Arrangement in Church for Sunday Assembly: 213 person limit.

Rows indicated 1 and 2 and reserved for couples or individuals.

Group pews are for groups living together of 3 or more persons.

The assorted rows in the nave will be adjusted according to the needs of the congregation.

All doors are exits. Only the door marked in green is an entrance. This is primarily for counting individuals and to ensure no one is seated without the assistance of an usher.

Ushers will guide or direct you to a seat. Please wait if they are already helping others.

General Guidelines

Please wear non-medical face masks inside and outside the church.

Observe every-other-pew seating and 6 foot social distancing.

Families and groups residing together may all sit together, but should still wear masks for the protection of others.

Please bring your own hand sanitizer for use as you see fit.

Collection baskets will be at the doors of the church.

Communion-in-hand is preferred.

Fr. Manning will come outside the church to distribute Holy Communion for those who would rather remain outside the church building for now.

Communion will be distributed after the final blessing. Father will distribute Eucharist in the front middle aisle, and an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion will distribute Eucharist to the congregation most distant from the altar. Please be alert to the directions of the ushers until we all learn the pattern.
