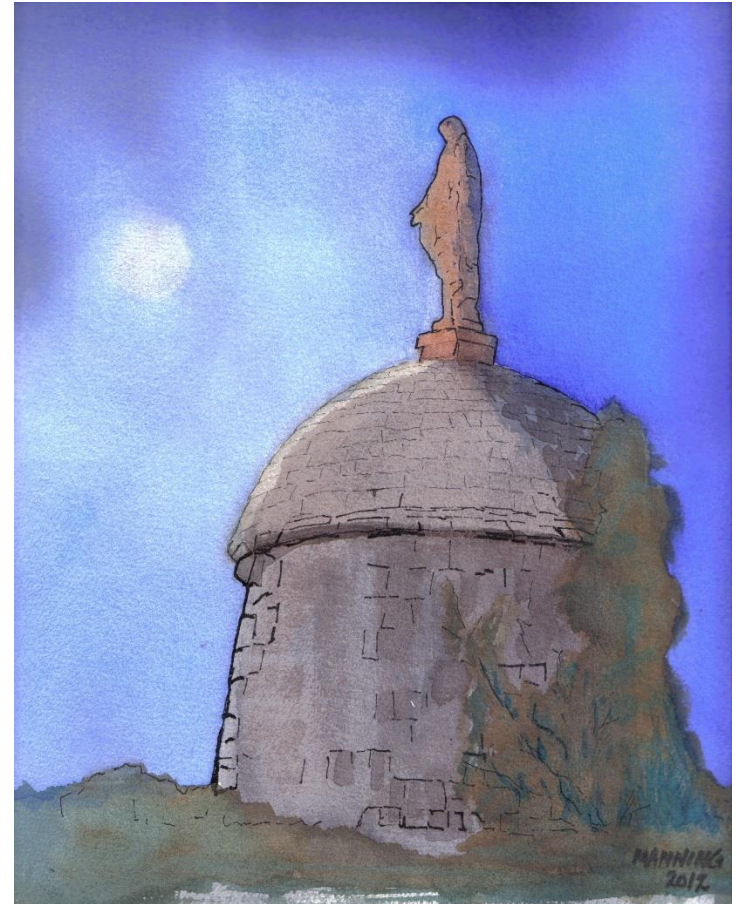
## CHRISTMAS MASSES

## HOLY CROSS CHURCH ADVENT 2018

*“Behold, the virgin shall be with child and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel, which means ‘God is with us.’”*


*Advent begins the Sunday nearest to the Feast of St. Andrew Apostle, November 30, and continues until Christmas Eve. The word "Advent" comes from the Latin "adventus," which means "coming." It refers to the four weeks prior to Christmas and always contains four Sundays.*


*Our anticipation of Christmas makes these four weeks a very special time of year. Advent is the perfect time to rediscover the joy of faith. During these weeks we focus on the "coming" of Jesus in three ways. We start the season by looking forward to the time when Jesus will come again in glory as our Triumphant King. As the days progress, we switch our attention to recalling and celebrating that time when Jesus first came among us as a little child. Throughout the whole season, we prepare for the coming of the Lord in our own hearts. When at last, the big day arrives, we welcome our Savior into hearts prepared for His coming.*
